This a 3 year post, with an option to extend as funding becomes available.

Hours: 30-37 hours per week, with some flexibility. Five weeks annual leave plus bank holidays. Will include weekend and evening work. A job share is possible.

The aim of the project is to grow communities of faith in Hartlepool through genuine community service and building relationships, with an emphasis on the vulnerable, marginalised, children and families.

Project background:

Hartlepool Communities of Hope is a project that has been running for one year, challenging poverty and working the marginalised, children and families. The remit is broad, and the need is great, but by using prayer, creativity, community involvement, strong partnerships and discerning what the Holy Spirit is up to, we seek to increase Hope in this amazing town.

The Project will work in partnership with existing congregations in the 'The Central Hartlepool Group of Churches' (All Saints Stranton, St Aidan and Columba, and St Luke's).

This project is part of a wider project in the Diocese of Durham which in a partnership with the National Church (Strategic Development Fund) seeks to invest in low-income communities in ways that bring hope and transformation, both spiritually and physically.

We are looking for an experienced and enthusiastic Christian to lead the project, coordinate a team and to encourage others in developing and leading the Communities of Hope project, in Jesus' name.

The **Project Leader** will build on the work of the last year continuing to develop all aspects of the project with an emphasis on building relationships, team work, good practice and communication.
